## DRESS CODE

Membership in Beach Grove Golf Club is a pleasure and a privilege. Only by dressing in good taste can this pleasure be shared by all.

In addition to appropriate Golf Slacks, Junior Men may wear Bermuda length shorts. Junior Ladies may wear slacks, golf skirts and/or golf dresses, Bermuda length of walking shorts.

During play, proper golf shoes must be worn—this applies to all players. Caps and hats considered to be in good taste may be worn on the course.

The Dress Code is essentially as recommended by the Golf Association which requires players to be neat and *prohibits* the following:

**JUNIOR MEN:** Denim jeans, tennis shorts, t-shirts without collars, cut offs, tank tops, football shirts, sweat pants, track pants and shirts with offensive slogans, numbers or illustrations.

**JUNIOR LADIES:** Halter tops, spaghetti straps, strapless tops, denim jeans, tennis shorts, sweat pants, track pants

The Club Professional and his Staff have been instructed to enforce the Dress Code, and are empowered to refuse play for non-compliance.

## PLAYING PRIVILEGES

Juniors may book times during Open Tee Times. Juniors may book times, and may not be bumped from 3:30 to 5:00 p.m. *EXCEPT WEDNESDAYS.*

Play is restricted to start no earlier than 7:00 a.m. Absolutely no play is to be allowed on the golf course prior to this time. This is to enable our Golf Course Maintenance Crew to get ahead of play.
